

River Edge Walk

1. Car parking constructed with reinforced gravel bays and cobble vehicle overrun forming a pedestrian friendly path down to the river edge
2. Existing seating pockets enhanced and linked to the new river edge trail path with gabion type terracing.
3. River edge path threaded through existing trees utilising a 'no-dig' construction
4. Paved thresholds to new retail frontages consisting of banded sett paving.
5. 'No-dig' decked surface around large trunks to river edge trees, creating public spill out spaces and terraces towards the river edge.
6. More varied terraces to river edge, small scale spaces to sit and greater public

7. Existing soft edges enhanced with new biodiverse ground flora. Existing trees managed for habitat value.
8. Existing embankment trees enhanced with new diverse ground flora
9. Opportunity to re-connect to existing path and potential improvements to War Memorial/Trinity Street. (Nb. works outside red line are shown indicatively)
10. Small scale space directly next to the riverbank
11. Vehicle arrival threshold and turning area-sett paving-pedestrian priority
12. Existing tarmac enhanced as ground cover planting area and small tree

- Varied external furniture including tables and high bench seating
 - Planters and removable bollards restricting vehicle access to river-except maintenance
 - Banded sett paving
 - Cobble sett paving engineered to allow vehicle turning
 - Old St to have new kerbs and existing cobbles to be retained/ repaired as feasible.
 - Stepping logs informal path
 - Biodiverse/understorey river edge planting
 - High quality balustrade/river edge protection
 - Gabion terraces-extending existing retaining walls and linking to new path
 - Drifts of seasonal planting under retained trees
 - 1.8m railing/gate to top of steps/path
