<b>Subject:</b>	<b>DEVELOPING A SINGLE COMMISSIONING STRATEGY</b>
<b>Report Summary:</b>	<p>Presentation provides an overview of the emerging commissioning strategy for the Tameside and Glossop single commission.</p> <p>It is based upon discussions with key members of staff from the single commission and Tameside Hospital Foundation Trust, councillors and GPs, two staff workshops and a review of existing plans and strategies.</p> <p>It suggests an initial focus on 4 key commissioning priorities. These have been identified as the areas which can have the biggest impact on improving health and wellbeing whilst reducing long term costs.</p>
<b>Recommendations:</b>	Members of the Health and Wellbeing Board are requested to receive and note the presentation and contribute to the development of the emerging strategic aims.
<b>Links to Community Strategy:</b>	Healthy Tameside – Improve the health and wellbeing of our residents.
