SUBJECT MATTER:	PUBLICATION OF MEMBERS INTERESTS ON THE WEB
REPORT SUMMARY:	<p>Members are currently required under the Code of Conduct to record financial and certain other personal interests in a register available for public inspection. Any changes to those details also have to be notified to the Monitoring Officer within 28 days of the change taking place. Currently the Register is kept in a paper copy format and is available for public inspection at the Council's Offices during normal office hours. Publishing the registers on the web site would make the information much more readily accessible, would accord with best practice and would demonstrate the Council's commitment to openness and high ethical standards. To consider the revised format for publication of the Register of Members' Interests on the Council's website following consideration at the October 2011 meeting.</p>
