

Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions

1 Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

Off Licence Premises

All supplies of alcohol

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-

(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or

(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

2. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Age verification policy

1. The premises licence holder must ensure that an age verification policy is adopted in respect of the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

2. The designated premises supervisor in relation to the premises licence must ensure that the supply of alcohol at the premises is carried on in accordance with the age verification policy.

3. The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and either—

a) a holographic mark, or

b) an ultraviolet feature.

Minimum Cost of Alcohol

A relevant person shall ensure that no alcohol is sold or supplied for consumption on or off the premises for a price which is less than the permitted price.

For the purposes of the condition

a) "duty" is to be construed in accordance with the Alcoholic Liquor Duties Act 1979;

b) "permitted price" is the price found by applying the formula-

$$P = D + (D \times V)$$

where-

(i) P is the permitted price,

(ii) D is the amount of duty chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the duty were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol, and

(iii) V is the rate of value added tax chargeable in relation to the alcohol as if the value added tax were charged on the date of the sale or supply of the alcohol;

c) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a premises licence-

- (i) the holder of the premises licence,
- (ii) the designated premises supervisor (if any) in respect of such a licence, or
- (iii) the personal licence holder who makes or authorises a supply of alcohol under such a licence;

d) "relevant person" means, in relation to premises in respect of which there is in force a club premises certificate, any member or officer of the club present on the premises in a capacity which enables the member or officer to prevent the supply in question; and

- e) "valued added tax" means value added tax charged in accordance with the Value Added Tax Act 1994.

Where the permitted price given by the calculation is not a whole number of pennies, the price given by that calculation shall be taken to be the price rounded up to the nearest penny.

1 ANNEX 2 - CONDITIONS CONSISTENT WITH THE OPERATING SCHEDULE

(a) General - all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

- i. A full risk assessment has been carried out at the premises.
- ii. Digital CCTV to be installed with 8 internal cameras and 3 external covering the front, side and rear of the premises.
- iii. Images securely stored on hard drive for a minimum of 31 days.
- iv. Premises are secured and alarmed when closed.
- v. Roller shutters secure the front of the building when closed.
- vi. Security doors fitted at the rear.

(b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- i. Limited supplies of alcohol to be stored on the premises.
- ii. Spirits and high value wines will be stored and served from behind the counter.
- iii. The premises will operate various log books to record; Incidents of Crime, Customer Refusals, ID signatures, Alcohol Authorisation book.
- iv. CCTV monitor positioned near the point of sale.

(c) Public safety

i. No risk has been assessed.

(d) The prevention of public nuisance

i. Signs will be displayed requesting customers to respect the local residents when leaving the premises.

The outside area will be monitored via CCTV for suspected proxy sales and staff will take all reasonable steps to discourage customers from congregating outside the premises so as not to cause a noise disturbance to nearby residents.

(e) The protection of children from harm

i. The premises will fully operate the Age Verification Scheme of Challenge 25 with the appropriate signage displayed on the premises in prominent positions, together with the Customer Refusals log book and ID signatures log book.

ii. Signage with regard to proxy sales will be displayed.
