1. I am Lauren O'Toole and I have been employed by Tameside MBC as a Regulatory Compliance Officer for Tameside Council since January 2022.
2. My duties include, amongst other things, the administration and regulation of the Licensing Act 2003 which governs the licensing of premises and their authorised activities under the Act.
3. I submit this statement to support and provide further evidence, following the premises licence review application in respect of Save More, 75-77 Market Street, Droylsden, which was submitted by the Rebecca Birch on behalf of the Licensing Authority on 20 October 2022.
4. Save More, 75-77 Market Street, Droylsden, PL210038, has held a premises licence since 18 December 2020.
5. On 7 September 2022, I was contacted by Mike Robinson, Regulatory Services Manager (Licensing) to accompany him on a premises inspection to Save More. A Waste Day of Action was carried out on this day in Droylsden. Waste at the rear of Save More led Officers to inspect the rear of the store, where a vehicle was parked at the rear of the premises found to contain illicit tobacco, cannabis and a till

containing money. Trading Standards Officers, Tracy Jones and Nicola Briers were called and attended the premises along with PC Craig Foley, Greater Manchester Police Licensing Officer for the Tameside District. The vehicle was subsequently seized by the Police.

6. On 7 September 2022 at approximately 13:10, I accompanied Mike Robinson, Regulatory Services Manager, to conduct a full inspection of the premises. This was following a telephone call received by Mr Robinson from the Trading Standards Officers who were at the premises.
7. The Trading Standards Officers were requesting footage from the CCTV system as one of the cameras was focussed on the area where the vehicle was parked.
8. Upon our arrival to the premises it was identified that the Premises Licence Holder and the Designated Premises Supervisor were no longer associated with the business. Mr Ibrahim Abdi identified himself as the new business owner. On this visit, Mr Abdi was unable to locate the CCTV hard drive within the premises. Mr Abdi advised that when he purchased the business, the previous owner did not inform him of the location of the hard drive or how to operate the system. Additionally, seven out of nine conditions of the licence were not being complied with, including;
 - i) CCTV – hard drive could not be located at time of visit so it was not possible to check that the system was compliant with the condition, the new business owner was unable to locate this, no CCTV system checks were being carried out, no posters.
 - ii) No record of Authorisations for selling alcohol available
 - iii) No Staff training records available for inspection.

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- iv) No refusals book available for inspection.
- v) No Challenge 25 Posters on display
- vi) No Proxy Notices on display
- vii) Drug Paraphernalia on display and available for sale

The report of the premises inspection is attached as **LOT01**. A copy of this report was left with Mr Abdi and he was advised if the store were to carry out any licensable activities, offences may be committed under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003. I emailed Mr Abdi later the same afternoon with the forms to transfer the Premises Licence and vary the DPS.

9. On 8 September 2022 I hand delivered a letter to Save More for Mr Abdi. This letter identified the licence breaches found on the inspection from 7 September and reiterated that to carry out any licensable activities would be an offence under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003. A copy of this letter is attached as **LOT02**. Additionally I provided Mr Abdi with a refusals book, authorisations sheet and Challenge 25 posters. I requested that Mr Abdi contacted me once the issues had been rectified and I would arrange a further compliance visit.

10. On 9 September 2022 Mr Abdi submitted an application for the transfer of the premises licence and to vary the DPS to Fakheraddin Qazizadeh. No right to work document was provided with the application, so I visited Save More alongside PC Foley to advise Mr Abdi on what he needed to provide. Mr Abdi emailed over the right to work documents for the new DPS to Licensing email. The transfer of Premises Licence to Mr Abdi and the vary of DPS application were circulated on this date. I also provided Mr Abdi with Proxy notices on this visit.

11. Following the visits, which took place on 7th, 8th and 9th September, I had not received confirmation that the premises was now operating in compliance with the condition of the premises licence. I had reason to believe that the premises was continuing to sell alcohol despite not operating in compliance. Therefore, on 14 September 2022 at 13:21, a test purchase was carried out by Rebecca Birch, Regulatory Compliance Officer. On this visit, a bottle of wine was purchased. I then undertook a further visit alongside Sharon Campbell, Regulatory Compliance Officer to carry out a premises inspection. Mr Abdi was not present in the store on this occasion, but he was contacted via phone during the visit. Whilst some improvements were noted on this visit, the following conditions were still not being complied with:

- I. CCTV – no person on site able to demonstrate system, record/burn footage to a storage device, no CCTV check sheet with weekly checks completed, no CCTV signage
- II. List of Authorised Persons – blank copy provided by myself, has not been completed by DPS and staff members
- III. Staff Training – no records available

The completed premises inspection from this visit can be found attached at **LOT03**. A copy of this form was left at the premises. This visit was followed up with an email to Mr Abdi advising him of the breaches that were identified on this visit, this can be found attached at **LOT04**. Mr Abdi was advised to remove alcohol from sale and that if any licensable activities were to take place, they would be committing offences under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003

12. On 22 September 2022 at 09:59hrs another test purchase was carried out by Nicola

Healey, Regulatory Support Officer. On this occasion a bottle of WKD blue was purchased. At 11:40hrs, I carried out a Premises Licence Inspection alongside Sharon Campbell. The staff member working at the time of this inspection showed the location of the hard drive for the CCTV system in the ceiling tiles in front of the counter. On this visit, the following conditions were identified as being breached:

- I. CCTV – not storing footage for 28 days minimum, no person on site able to demonstrate system fully, record/burn footage to a storage device, no CCTV check sheet with weekly checks completed, no CCTV signage
- II. Staff Training – no records available

The completed premises inspection from this visit can be found attached at **LOT05**. A copy of this form was left at the premises. Mr Abdi was not present on this visit, but contact was made via phone during the visit. I discussed the conditions that were still not being complied with, Mr Abdi requested this be sent to him via email. An email was sent to Mr Abdi to advise him of the breaches identified on this visit, a copy of which can be found at **LOT06**. Again, Mr Abdi was advised to remove alcohol from sale and that if any licensable activities were to take place, they would be committing offences under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003

13. On 26th September 2022 I received an email from Mr Abdi, advising that he had addressed the breaches of conditions identified previously. I attended later the same day to carry out a Premises Inspection. On this visit, the following breaches were identified:

- I. CCTV –no CCTV check sheet with weekly checks completed
- II. Staff Training – no records available

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A copy of the inspection form from this visit can be found at **LOT07**, a copy of which was left at the premises. Mr Abdi was not present in store on this visit, contact was made via phone. Mr Abdi expressed frustration at the advice provided regarding the breaches of the licence conditions telling me this was ruining his business. I advised that all correspondence I had provided to date had clearly listed the actions needed for the store to be compliant, he needed to read this correspondence and action it fully. Mr Abdi requested this information be sent to him via email again. A further email was sent to Mr Abdi to advise him of the breaches identified on this visit, a copy of which can be found at **LOT08**. Mr Abdi was advised to remove alcohol from sale and that if any licensable activities were to take place, they would be committing offences under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003

14. On 13 October 2022, a visit to Save More was made by Trading Standards along with Wagtails detection dogs. On this visit, illicit tobacco was seized from the premises. Rebecca Birch, Regulatory Compliance Officer, carried out a premises inspection at 12:40hrs where the following breaches were identified:

- I. CCTV – staff member unable to operate system, could not supply any footage, no CCTV checks being conducted.
- II. Refusals book – no entries
- III. Authorisations list – member of staff working not listed on sheet
- IV. Staff training – no records available

A copy of the premises inspection sheet from this visit can be found at **LOT09**.

15. Ms Birch carried out a second inspection later this day at 14:50hrs with Mr Abdi

present. The following breaches were identified:

- I. CCTV – does not record for 28 days, last date 29 September 2022. No portable drives to supply footage. No CCTV checks being conducted.
- II. Challenge 25 – licence holder/manager (Mr Abdi) did not understand
- III. Staff training – no records available, not being carried out
- IV. Authorisations list – not correct
- V. DPS not involved at the premises

A copy of this premises inspection can be found at **LOT10**. Once more, Mr Abdi was advised to remove alcohol from sale and that if any licensable activities were to take place, offences may be committed under section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003.

16. On 17 October 2022, a Late Temporary Event Notice to permit the sale of alcohol from the premises, between 25th – 30th October 2022, was submitted by Mr Abdi. On 20 October the Licensing Authority received an objection to this application from Greater Manchester Police. Following this, a counter notice was served on Mr Abdi to inform his that the application was rejected and licensable activities would be unauthorised.

17. On 20th October 2022, a Review of Premise Application was submitted by Rebecca Birch, on behalf of the Licensing Authority in respect of Save More, 75-77 Market Street, Droylsden.

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18. On 31 October 2022, Mr Abdi submitted a Vary DPS application for the premises,

nominating Zanyar Hasan Njad as the new DPS. Mr Abdi contacted me to inform me that along with the Vary DPS, he had rectified all the breaches identified on previous visits. On 1 November 2022, I visited the premises along with PC Craig Foley. On this visit, the new DPS was present along with Mr Abdi. I undertook a Premises Inspection and noted improvements in all areas. The inspection form can be seen at **LOT11**. On this occasion I advised Mr Abdi that the store could resume licensable activities.

I am writing to you following my visit to Save More, 75-77 Market Street, Droylsden.

I visited the premises along with Mike Robinson, Licensing Manager, on 7 September 2022 and found there to be breaches of a number of licence conditions. They have been summarised below:

- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: DPS named on licence has left business
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: CCTV unable to locate hard drive
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No CCTV Checks being Completed
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No CCTV signage
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No Staff Training
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No Authorisations List
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No refusals book
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: Challenge 25 – no posters on display
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: No Proxy Notices on display
- LICENCE CONDITION BREACH: Drug Paraphernalia on display and available for sale

During our visit, Mr Robinson spoke with you regarding the breach of conditions.

You must make it your priority to address the matters outlined above as you are not trading in accordance with your Premises Licence. **By failing to do so, you are committing offences under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003.** A copy of this letter will be kept on file.

On this visit we were informed that the named Premises Licence Holder and DPS on your Premises Licence, Hawbash Shorsh Hamza, had left the business approximately 6 weeks earlier. You were sent the necessary application forms via email to apply for a Licence transfer and variation of DPS and advised this needed to be completed and sent to Licensing before you could resume selling alcohol.

I will complete another visit at your premises in the near future in order to check you are now fully compliant with all licence conditions.

A test purchase was carried out at this premises today, Wednesday 14 September 2022, by a Compliance Officer where a bottle of wine was purchased at 13:21hrs.

A compliance visit was then carried out by myself and Sharon Campbell, Regulatory Compliance Officer. On this visit the conditions on your licence were checked for compliance.

The letter identifying previously identified areas of non-compliance is attached for your reference (letter dated and hand delivered on 8 September).

Upon my visit, I identified that some conditions are now being complied with:

- Challenge 25 posters and proxy notices are on display following the provision of these by myself.
- Refusals book is available, again provided by Tameside Council but I note that the details section has not been completed.
- Paraphernalia has now been removed from sale.

The following conditions are still not being complied with:

- CCTV – no person on site able to demonstrate system, record/burn footage to a storage device, no CCTV check sheet with weekly checks completed, no CCTV signage
- List of Authorised Persons – blank copy provided by myself, has not been completed by DPS and staff members
- Staff Training – no records available

Please refer to your licence for the full conditions – a copy was provided to you on Wednesday 7 September by Mike Robinson, Licensing Manager.

You must make it your priority to address the matters outlined above as you are not trading in accordance with your Premises Licence. **By failing to do so, you are committing offences under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003.** As discussed previously, any sale of alcohol while the premises remains non-compliant would be a breach of this.

Please contact me once you have rectified these issues and I will arrange to visit the premises in order to check compliance.

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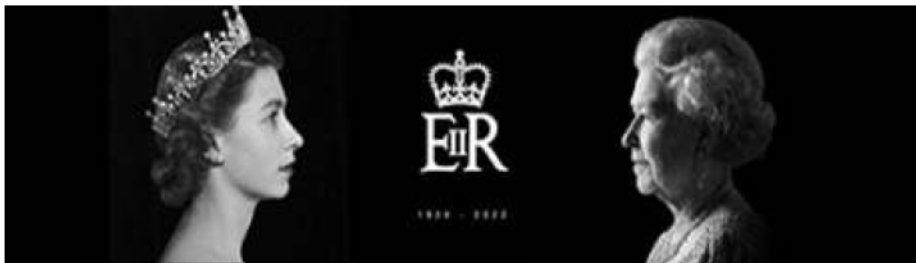
