

Tobacco and Related Product Regulations 2016
Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008.

On 8th July 2021, I visited your business at 7 Stockport Road, Hyde in response to a complaint received. The complaint alleges that your business sells illicit tobacco and sells single cigarettes to children,

At the time of my visit, I outlined a number of issues which came to my attention with Andrew Bridge. I am writing to confirm the issues I raised. I have also left Mr Bridge with a Record of Inspection.

Tobacco Notice

The Children and Young Persons Act 1933/ Children and Young Persons (Protection from Tobacco) Act 1991 require that retailers of tobacco products must display the following prescribed warning statement:-

IT IS ILLEGAL TO SELL TOBACCO PRODUCTS TO ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18

The notice must be displayed in a prominent position. It must not measure less than 297 mm x 420 mm and no characters should be less than 36 mm in height. I left Andrew Bridge a copy of the above notice at the time of my inspection, which should be displayed in accordance with the above legislation.

Sale of Single Cigarettes

The complaint I received stated that your business sells single cigarettes to children for either 50p or £1. Section 3 of The Children and Young Persons (Protection from Tobacco) Act 1991 states that it shall be an offence for any person carrying on a retail business to sell cigarettes to any

















person other than in their original package. Original packaging means the package in which the cigarettes were supplied for the purpose of retail sale by the manufacturer or importer. The current penalty for this offence is a fine of up to £1000.

Under The Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016, cigarettes can only legally be sold in plain packs of 20, with health warnings. Failure to comply with these requirements is an offence under regulation 48 of The Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016. The current penalty for this offence is a fine of up to £5,000 and / or 3 month imprisonment.

You must not sell single cigarettes

Sale of cigarettes to children under the age of 18

The law states that it is an offence for any person to sell any tobacco products (including cigarette papers) to a person under 18, whether or not it was for their own use. This is a strict liability offence, which means the owner of the business can be held responsible as well as the member of staff who made the sale. If you are charged with this offence, you have the defence that you took all reasonable precautions and exercised all due diligence to avoid committing the offence. This is commonly known as the 'due diligence' defence.

In order to keep within the law and therefore satisfy the legal defences, you should introduce an age verification policy and have effective systems to prevent sales and display to under-18s. These systems should be regularly monitored and updated as necessary to identify and put right any problems or weaknesses, and to keep pace with any advances in technology. For further information as to the systems you should put in place please go www.businesscompanion.info/en/quick-quides/underage-sales/tobacco-and-nicotine-inhaling-products. One part of these systems is to complete a refusals log. A refusals book was left at the time of my visit.

For further information on how to ensure the sale of alcohol does not take place at your premises please go to www.businesscompanion.info/en/quick-guides/underage-sales/alcohol.

Sale of illicit tobacco.

Tameside Trading Standards is responsible for the enforcement of the above legislation within the Borough of Tameside and acts to enforce it to ensure the sale of cigarettes comply with the requirements laid down in the regulations.

During my visit, I seized 6 packets of Amber Leaf rolling tobacco from the stock room / back room of your premises at 7 Stockport Road, Hyde, Tameside as they were non-duty paid and in foreign labelled packaging.

The supply or possession for supply of cigarettes in non-standardised packaging and non-duty paid tobacco is a criminal offence under the above Regulations. The current penalty for each offence under the Tobacco and Related Products Regulations 2016 is a fine of up to £5000 or 3 months imprisonment. The current penalty for each offence under the Consumer Protection from Unfair Trading Regulations 2008 is a fine of upto £5000 and/or 2 years imprisonment.

I have enclosed some forms for you to sign the hand rolling tobacco over to this department for disposal. If you sign the top copy and return it to me to the address provided, no further action will be taken on this occasion. However, if you are found in possession of non-compliant tobacco in Tameside in future, a report will be submitted to our legal department with a recommendation for prosecution.

Pricing

Many items in your shop were not priced. When selling to the general public, all pricing information must be clearly legible, unambiguous, easily identifiable, in sterling, and inclusive of VAT and any additional taxes.

Pricing information must be given close to the goods. Prices can be shown:

- · on the goods themselves
- on a ticket or notice near to the goods
- grouped together with other prices on a list in close proximity to the goods.

Pricing information must be available and clearly visible to consumers without them having to ask for assistance in order to see it.

If you have any questions regarding the content of this letter, please do not hesitate to contact me. I intend to revisit your premises in the next two months to ensure that the above issues have been rectified.

Legal requirements in relation to Tobacco, E-cigarettes and E-Liquids

We are writing to you today to provide some guidance on some of the legal obligations for retailers when it comes to the sale of tobacco products, e-cigarettes and e-liquids. If you are selling these products then we ask that you familiarise yourself with the following guidance and satisfy yourself that you are trading within the law.

Tobacco Products

Under the Children and Young Persons (Protection from Tobacco) Act 1991 it is a legal requirement to display the notice below, where any tobacco products are being sold. Please be aware that cigarette papers are considered a tobacco product for the purpose of this age restriction.

To obtain a free cardboard copy of this notice for your business please send a request to publicprotection-es@tameside.gov.uk

IT IS ILLEGAL TO SELL **TOBACCO PRODUCTS** TO ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18

Under the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 it is an offence to sell tobacco products to anyone under the age of 18 so please remain vigilant when it comes to asking young people to produce proof of their age.

















E cigarettes and E Liquids (Nicotine inhaling products)

The Nicotine Inhaling Products (Age of Sale and Proxy Purchasing) Regulations 2015 prohibit the sale of Nicotine inhaling products (which includes e liquid refill containers) to persons under 18, therefore a person who sells any e-cigarettes or e-liquids to someone under 18 is committing an offence.

If you sell e-cigarettes and associated devices you might want to display a poster advising customers that you will not sell to under-18s:

To assist you to stay within the law in relation to under age sales and help demonstrate due diligence in the event of enforcement action by Trading Standards, there are also a number of best practice procedures that you can implement as part of your age verification policy. These are as follows:

Operate a Challenge 21 or Challenge 25 policy

This means that if the person appears to be under 21 or 25, they will be asked to verify that they are 18 or over by showing valid proof of age.

Staff training

Make sure your staff are properly trained. They should know which products are age restricted, what the age restriction is and the action they must take if they believe a person under 18 is attempting to buy. It is important that you can prove your staff have understood what is required of them under the legislation. This can be done by keeping a record of the training and asking the member of staff to sign to say that they have understood it. These records should then be checked and signed on a regular basis by management or the owner.

Maintain a refusals log

All refusals of tobacco and tobacco products should be recorded (date, time, incident, description of potential buyer). Maintaining a refusals log will help to demonstrate that you actively refuse sales and have an effective system in place. Logs should be checked by the manager / owner to ensure that all members of staff are using them.

Labelling of E-cigarettes and E-liquids – selling compliant products

To ensure that you are only selling legally compliant products we ask that you familiarise yourself with the guidance on the following website:

https://www.gov.uk/guidance/e-cigarettes-regulations-for-consumer-products

Important issues to be aware of are as follows:

- -all e-cigarettes and e-liquids are required to be notified to the MHRA (Medicines and Healthcare products Regulatory Agency) before they can be sold. Notification is the responsibility of the manufacturer or importer but as a retailer you should check that a compliant notification has been published on the lists available on the above website when sourcing new products. If in doubt ask your supplier to demonstrate that the product has been notified.
- -the volume of e-cigarette tanks (including disposable e cigarettes) is not permitted to be more than 2 ml
- -the maximum volume of nicotine-containing e-liquid in a refill container is not permitted to be above 10 ml
- -the nicotine strength of e-liquids is not permitted to be more than 20 mg/ml (2 %)
- -E-cigarettes and e-liquids must be in tamper-evident and child-resistant packaging
- -The products must be labelled with the following:
 - -List of ingredients in nicotine-containing liquid, if present
 - -Indication of nicotine content and delivery per dose
 - -Batch number
 - -Recommendation to keep the product out of the reach of children
 - -Prominent health warning in black text on a white background on front and back -
 - "This product contains nicotine which is a highly addictive substance"
 - -Contact details of a **UK based** manufacturer or importer

Nicotine-containing e-liquids are also required to be labelled with safety information under the **CLP Regulation** (classification, labelling and packaging of substances). Under this regulation nicotine is classified as a hazardous substance and therefore products must be labelled with certain warnings and safety instructions, depending on the amount of nicotine present. When sourcing new products you should check to make sure one of the pictograms and accompanying information below is present on the labelling.



For nicotine-containing e-liquids <u>below</u> 18 mg/ml (1.8 %). It must also be accompanied by the words 'Warning' and 'Harmful if swallowed'



For nicotine-containing e-liquids of 18 mg/ml (1.8 %) and above. It must also be accompanied by the words 'Danger' and 'Toxic if swallowed'

It is an offence to supply e-cigarettes and e-liquids that don't comply with the above requirements so it is important that you as a retailer check the products you are sourcing, to ensure that they are compliant, and that the manufacturer or importer has complied with the necessary legal requirements.

Penalties for non-compliance

Failure to comply with the requirements outlined above may lead to enforcement action by Trading Standards and if you are found guilty of an offence then you may be liable to a fine and/or a prison sentence. Therefore, we ask that you give the issues raised in this letter your due consideration and satisfy yourself that are trading lawfully.
