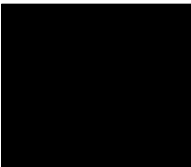

Dear Sir,

The Licensing Act 2003 – Notification of Decision of Panel - Fletchers Arms Denton.


Thank you for attending the Panel hearing held on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2005 at which consideration was given to your application for an existing licence to be converted to a premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 and application to vary the premises licence simultaneously, in respect of the Fletchers Arms Denton.

The Panel in reaching its decision took into account all the representations made, including photographic evidence, the Panel were satisfied that the applicant had taken adequate measures to prevent a break out of noise nuisance by installing a clear sound barrier with trees and shrubs. In addition the applicant shown evidence of signs erected in the car park area, requesting customers to leave the premises quietly with consideration to local residents. In accordance with the Council's Licensing Policy made the following decision:

The Panel also noted that in regard to live and recorded music, the representation made by Mr Duffy did not raise any concerns regarding this part of the application.
