

## APPENDIX 4

### THE TAMESIDE METROPOLITAN BOROUGH (ST GEORGES ROAD AND GREENSIDE LANE, DROYLSDEN) (PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2024

Please notice that all representations sent in response to this Notice are public documents and may be viewed by anyone. Tameside Metropolitan Borough Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effects of which will be to introduce No Waiting at Any Time restrictions on: -

(1) Coronation Road (both sides) from its junction with St Georges Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction; (2) Greenside Lane (west side) from a point 10 metres north of its junction with St Martins Close to a point 10 metres south of that junction; (3) Kelsall Drive (both sides) from its junction with St Georges Road for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction; (4) Springfield Road (north side) from a point 10 metres west of its junction with St Georges Road to a point 10 metres east of that junction; (5) St Georges Road (both sides) from its junction with Sunnyside Road for a distance of 10 metres in a southerly direction; (6) St Georges Road (east side) from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Kelsall Drive to a point 10 metres south of that junction; (7) St Georges Road (east side) from a point 10 metres north of its junction with Coronation Road to a point 10 metres south of that junction; (8) St Georges Road (west side) from its junction with Springfield Road for a distance of 18 metres in a northerly direction; (9) St Georges Road (east side) from its junction with Springfield Road for a distance of 10 metres in a northerly direction; (10) St Martins Close (both sides) from its junction with Greenside Lane for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction; (11) Sunnyside Road (south side) from a point 15 metres west of its junction with St Georges Road to a point 10 metres east of that junction.
