**Subject:** GM OUTCOMES FRAMEWORK AND DASHBOARD

**Report Summary:** This report provides an update in relation to establishing a GM Population Health Outcomes Framework, including a Tableau based online dashboard, as part of a Single Integrated Assurance process.

A GM Population Health Outcomes Framework has been developed through a process of engagement and co-design with key stakeholders from across the Health and Social Care system and the wider Public Service.

The framework focuses upon the key Population Health outcomes which adversely impact upon the health and wellbeing of the Greater Manchester population and seeks to place focus and emphasis on a reduced number of key indicators, from within the multiple thousands of measures that currently exist within the wider system.

**Recommendations:** The Health and Wellbeing Board is requested to discuss and note the content and progress of the Framework and Dashboard.

**Links to Health and Wellbeing Strategy:** Delivery of the local aspirations for population health requires significant collaboration and cooperation across GM. This Outcomes Framework provides a powerful contribution to more effective coordination of efforts across the conurbation.
