**Annex 1 – Mandatory conditions****Embedded Conditions - On Licences**

As an embedded condition the licence holder may permit the premises to be open for the sale of late night refreshment (non-alcoholic) until 11:30pm on Weekdays and Saturdays. And until 11:00pm on Sundays

As an embedded condition the premises is permitted to provide only recorded music or the reproduction by wireless (including television) broadcasts within the times stated for the sale of alcohol on the premises. Mandatory Conditions under the Licensing Act 2003:

(1) No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

(2) Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

1.(1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.

(2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children-

- (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to-
  - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
  - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
- (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
- (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on-
  - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
  - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
- (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

4.(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

The responsible person shall ensure that-

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures-

- (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older

age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

## **Annex 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule**

### **a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d, e):**

Door security from 9.00pm until closure Friday and Saturday (subject to service of alcohol after midnight).

### **b)The prevention of crime and disorder:**

who appears to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to purchase alcohol must be required to produce "proof of age", complying with the PASS accreditation system before such sale is made. No irresponsible sales promotions of alcoholic beverages shall be offered to customers.

### **c) Public safety**

When disabled people are present, adequate arrangements will be made to enable their safe evacuation in the event of an emergency. All escape routes and exits will be kept unobstructed, in good order with non slippery and even surfaces, free of trip hazards and clearly identified. All exit doors should be maintained so as to be capable of being opened easily. All fire doors will be maintained effectively, self closing and shall not be held open other than by approved devices. An adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials is to be made available on the premises.

### **d)The prevention of public nuisance:**

Noise or vibration will not emanate from the premises so as to cause a nuisance to nearby properties. Prominent, clear and legible notices are to be displayed at all exits requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

### **e)The protection of children from harm;**

who appears to be under the age of 18 and who is attempting to buy alcohol must be required to produce "proof-of age", complying with the PASS accreditation system before such sale is made.

## **Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority**

Panel Decision 11/1/2010 Following Application for a Variation

The Panel noted that the representations by Environmental Health could be overcome by an effective noise limiting device being installed; the Panel were advised that a limiting device had partly been installed.

The Panel therefore granted the variation to the premises licence in respect of the White House as requested with the addition of a condition relating to the noise limiting device:-

- 1.No regulated entertainment shall take place after 1 February 2010 unless a noise limiting set and operating in accordance with these conditions is in operation.
- 2.All sound equipment used by the DJ must draw electrical power only from sockets which are subject to being cut out by

the noise limiter.

3.The noise limiting system is to be set and maintained at a level to be agreed with Tameside MBC.

4.Once the noise limiting device has been set in accordance with 3 above

a)Its settings shall not be altered without the written permission of the Local Authority

b)A security tag shall be fitted to the noise limiting device so that its settings cannot be altered without removing the tag.

5.All external doors and windows must be kept closed, other than for egress and access, at all times when regulated entertainment is taking place.


These conditions are necessary and proportionate to uphold the four licensing objectives, in particular the prevention of public nuisance.
