Misuse of Drugs on the Premises (the prevention of crime and disorder)

Assaults on the premises (the prevention of crime and disorder)

Fighting and disorder involving Patrons from The Royal Oak on Lees Road (B6194) (the prevention of crime and disorder) (public safety)

Patrons urinating in the street (the prevention of public nuisance)

Patrons consuming alcohol in the street (the prevention of public nuisance)

This premises has been associated with an increase in reports of incidents and the Police have taken steps to work with both the DPS and representatives of Admiral Taverns in an attempt to prevent or reduce the risk of further incident occurring.

Despite these preventative measures the incidents of crime and disorder and Public nuisance have continued to occur.

Despite several attempts to retrieve footage from inside the Royal Oak the DPS has failed to provide the footage at the time of submitting this application.

#### 10th October 2019

Incident reported to Police x Tameside CCTV of incident occurring outside the Royal Oak Public House. CCTV Footage captures a patron of the Royal Oak Public urinating in the street before returning to the Pub via the front door.

### 11th October 2019

Incident reported to Police x Tameside CCTV of incident occurring outside the Royal Oak Public House. CCTV footage shows consumption of alcohol in the street with no fewer than 11 patrons being present on the pavement. A patron is captured on CCTV snorting drugs whilst in full view of members of the public. A customer from the Pub is prevented from passing by of the pavement due to the patrons congregating on the public footpath.

### 18th October 2019

Incident reported to Police x Tameside CCTV of incident occurring outside the Royal Oak Public House. The footage shows the DPS standing at the front door of the premises when a vehicle pulls off the car park. The driver of the car is clearly seen inhaling and exhaling from a balloon whilst driving. It is believed that the balloon contained Nitrous Oxide.

#### 29th December 2019

Incident reported to Police x Tameside CCTV of incident occurring outside the Royal Oak Public House. Large group and males and females outside the Pub and on Lees Road fighting / obstructing traffic. Incident Number 2906 261219 refers.

Royal Oak CCTV footage has been viewed from inside the premises. The footage from within the vault shows a group of three persons being escorted from the premises following a verbal altercation.

#### 1st January 2020

Incident reported to Police x Tameside CCTV of incident occurring outside the Royal Oak Public House. A male enters the pub approx. 02:00hrs, within a minute he is escorted out by the Landlady. A male then appears from the pub with a cut to his head. No altercation caught on TMBC camera, the incident happened inside the pub.

Royal Oak CCTV footage has been viewed from inside the premises and the footage in the vault shows a glass being thrown by offender which strikes the victim in the face.
