I am Police Constable 14627 Martin Thorley of the Greater Manchester Police stationed at Ashton-under-Lyne Police Station. My current role is that of Licensing Officer, Strategic Demand Reduction Team for the Tameside District.
I have delegation of authority on behalf of the Chief Officer of Police for all applications made in respect of the Licencing Act 2003.
I am aware that this statement will be used as part of an application for a review of the licensed premises <b>The Cock Hotel</b> , <b>60 Two Trees Lane</b> , <b>Denton M34 7SZ</b> .
At 2315hrs on Wednesday 25 <sup>th</sup> November 2020 PC Cookson sent me an email in relation to a breach of The Health Protection (Coronavirus Regulations) (No.4) (England) Regulations 2020. PC Cookson attended at The Cock Public House, 60 Two Trees Lane, Denton on Wednesday 25 <sup>th</sup> November at 1948hrs as a result of a report to Police (Incident Number 2067-251120) reporting that persons had been seen entering the Licensed Premises during a restricted period.
As a result of what was established by PC Cookson on his visit to Licensed Premises, five Fixed Penalty Notices were authorised for issuing for the offence of Contravening requirement not to participate in an indoor gathering of two or more people.
A Fixed Penalty was also authorised to be issued to the Designated Premises Supervisor, Michael Andrew in relation to business Restrictions in that he contravened a requirement to close a premises or business.
Body Worn Video worn by PC Cookson captures his visit and offers supporting evidence in relation to this incident.
On Thursday 26 <sup>th</sup> November 2020 I attended at The Cock Public House, 60 Two Trees Lane, Denton in company with Tameside Council Licensing Manager Mike Robison. On arrival at the premises I was met by a male I know to be Michael Andrew who I know to be the DPS at the premises. I was invited inside the premises where I spoke with the DPS under caution.
Mr Andrew claimed that the previous evening had been a one off and there had been no previous issues. He claimed he was lonely and opened to have company.

Mr Andrew showed me the bar area and demonstrated which beer lines were functioning. I could see that three lines were on and functioning. These being Carling, John Smiths and Stella Artois. All other lines appeared to have no more than water inside the lines.

Mr Andrew showed me an invoice from Pedlers Cash and Carry dated 21<sup>st</sup> November 2020 which was for a cash sale which he claimed he had made himself for the following alcohol purchases:-

- 11 Gallons of Carling @ £110,
- 11 Gallons of John Smiths @ £102.50
- 10 Gallons of Stella Artois @ £100.

The total of the invoice was £375 including VAT. I took a photograph of the Invoice which is exhibited as Exh Ref MRT/2.

Mr Andrew was asked to play various dates on the CCTV system which was in the upstairs office of the Premises. The system appeared to be a 16 channel system which had recording present from as far back as 9<sup>th</sup> September 2020. It was established during our visit that the CCTV was displaying the incorrect time by one hour. The CCTV footage was found to be of good quality though was showing 1408hrs when the actual time was 1308hrs.

Upon me viewing a couple of dates from the system it was evident that there had been previous breaches to the Covid 19 restriction and so I informed Mr Andrew that I would be seizing the CCTV System to establish if further offences had been committed. This CCTV Hard drive and System was seized at 1330hrs and is exhibited as Exh Ref MRT/1.

This CCTV Hard drive and system was later booked in to GMP Property Reference Number GG/053010/20 at Ashton Police Station.

Whilst Mr Andrew was under caution he was informed that he was to be issued with a Fixed Penalty Notice in relation to business Restrictions in that he contravened a requirement to close a premises or business. Mr Andrew was informed that this Fixed Penalty ticket was for £1000 before the visit was concluded and we left the premises.

At 1348hrs I telephoned Derick Cooper from EI Group informing him of what had occurred and what I had established during my visit in relation to the breach, offences and Fixed Penalty Notices.

I was later in receipt of an email timed at 1442hrs on 26<sup>th</sup> November 2020 from Joanne Hipkiss informing me that As premises licence holder for The Cock Hotel, EI Group, were to immediately remove Michael Andrew as DPS.

On Monday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2020 I attended at Greater Manchester Police CCTV Retrieval Unit at Stretford Police Station where I viewed the CCTV Exh Ref MRT/1.

I looked at dates identified by Mr Andrew when there had been football fixtures played and established that there were breaches as follows:-

I have focused on the following cameras from The Cock :-

- Camera 6 Behind the bar
- Camera 10 Rear entrance to the Pub
- Camera 11 Pool Room / Bar

EW1 CCTV Clips of Covid Breaches and unauthorised Licensable Activity

It is my opinion that having reviewed the CCTV footage in Exh Ref EW/1, Michael Andrew as DPS has committed offences under the Licensing Act 2003 by selling alcohol to customers outside of his licensable hours on more than one occasion. This together with the Covid 19 regulation Breaches are evidence of incidents of crime and disorder impacting on and affecting residents from the local community.


It is the case that the manner in which the premises have been managed, allowing the congregation of persons falls short of what is expected from a licensee in Promoting the Licensing Objectives.

Patrons leaving the premises as late as 0528hrs could have an adverse impact upon 'Public Nuisance' in a residential area affecting residents from the local community.

The Designated Premises Supervisor has put the welfare of staff, customers, attending Police, Council Officers and the wider members of the public in danger of contracting a potentially fatal illness. I consider the behaviour and actions of the management and staff at The Cock Hotel to have been totally irresponsible especially during the period of Tier 2 restrictions up until 4<sup>th</sup> November and within a period of a National Lockdown from 5<sup>th</sup> November onwards.

The instructions and regulations given to Licenced Premises are clear and should be understood by everybody. There is a clear risk to Public Health during a global pandemic.
